

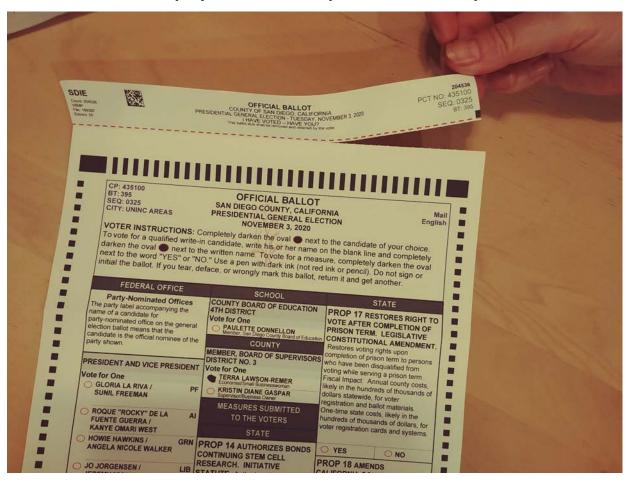
1. Use a black or blue pen ONLY to completely fill in the circle next to your choice.



(If you haven't received a ballot yet, check that you are properly registered at https://rov.sandiegocounty.gov/rov/Eng/Voters.asp, then call the Registrar's office at 858-565-5800.)

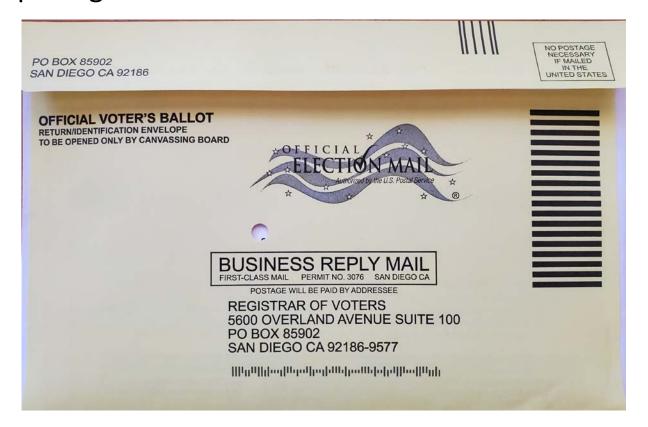


2. Tear off and keep your receipt at the top of the ballot.



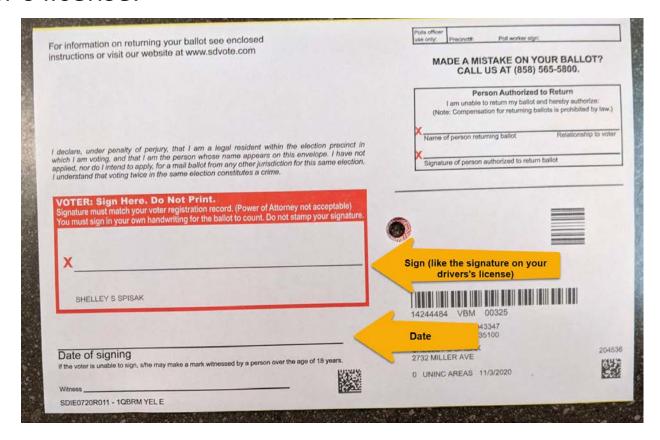


3. Put your completed ballot in the envelope and seal. No postage needed.



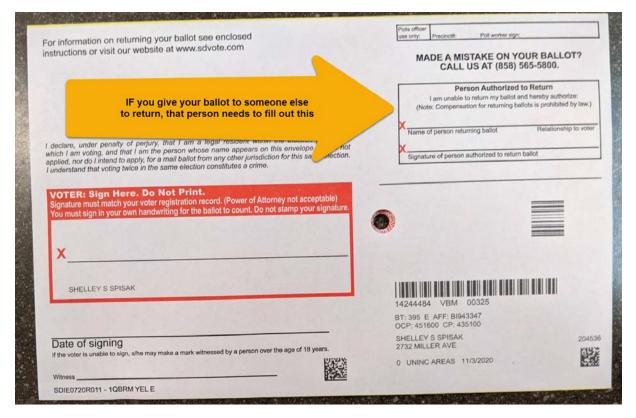


4. Sign and date the envelope. Use the same signature as on your driver's license.





5. If you are giving your ballot to someone else to drop off for you, have them fill out the box in the upper right: their printed name, relationship to you, their signature.

- By US Mail. Mail it early to be sure it gets there on time.

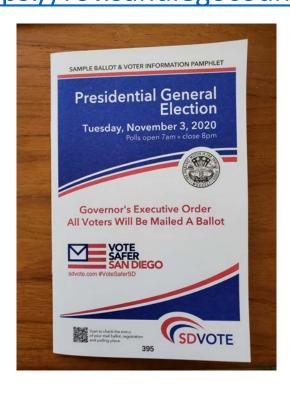

2. VOTE!

- You may vote at your polling place Saturday October 31 through Tuesday November 3.
- You may vote at the Registrar's Office Monday Friday, starting October 5.
- Wear your mask, and be prepared for long lines.
- The earlier you vote the better.
